

## How to arrive in Aveiro?

If you come by aeroplane, you can fly to Porto (OPO) or to Lisbon (LIS).

**From Porto** (sometimes also called Oporto in English – the same city) airport to Aveiro (this option is less than 2 hours):

Francisco Sá Carneiro Airport take the Metro line E (purple) to Campanha Railway station, and then you can take any train to Aveiro.

The Metro takes 30 mins, and there is one every 30 mins from the airport, from 06.00-00.30. Buy a Z4 ticket at the machines at the airport Metro (€1.80 + 0.50 for the re-usable ticket). <http://en.metroporto.pt/>

There are many trains from Porto Campanha to Aveiro, from 05.00 to 00.59. Urbano trains are the most common and cheapest (U, €3.50), and take ~1 hour. Intercity (IC) and Alfa (AP) trains are quicker, but cost a lot more (IC €11.90 37 min, AP €14.50 32 min). See <https://www.cp.pt/passageiros/en> to search for train times and costs.

**From Lisbon** airport to Aveiro will take at least 2h30m if you pick the fastest train:

From Lisbon Portela Airport take the metro to Oriente Station, then you can take any train to Aveiro, the fastest is Alfa Pendular that takes 2 hours to Aveiro (AP €26.70), while IC trains take 2 h 20 mins (IC €20.60). See <https://www.cp.pt/passageiros/en> for times and prices. There are about 20 trains per day, from 06.00 to 21.30.

**On arrival in Aveiro**, the Hotel Melia Ria is a 10 minute walk, or 4 minutes by taxi, from the station

From Melia Hotel to the Universidade de Aveiro Rectory is 20 minutes' walk or 7 minutes by táxi – taxi will cost about €3.50.

Any other central hotels will be 10-20 minutes' walk, or the same taxi fee.
